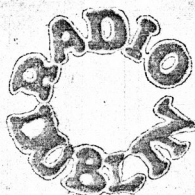

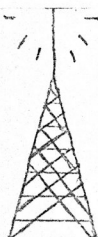

FREE RADIO CAMPAIGN IRELAND - NEWSDESK.....

Sunday 3rd Oct '76 and A.B.C. England were raided. The Home Office confiscated a 200 watt transmitter plus the power supply. A.B.C.E. continue with a 40 watt tx. on 6270KHz.....Radio Valleri received their first reception report from Italy in Oct. R.V. also celebrated their 3rd birthday on 17th Oct....
...World Music Radio 6230KHz 49mb S.W. commenced broadcasting on Aug. 28th '76 from 8.00 to 14.00hrs (G.M.T.) Saturdays. But by October the service had closed down. "Lack of advertising funds has led to the premature close, but it is hoped to resume services as soon as fresh backers can be found for the operation". - from Record Mirror 16/10/76. W.M.R. had been broadcasting via the transmitting facilities of Radio Andorra, from the Principality of Andorra, high in the mountains of the Pyrenees between France and Spain.....Radio Mi Amigo introduced a pop news service in Nov. It's in English and is aired every Wednesday at 16.30hrs (G.M.T.) and includes the Nol U.K. Disco Single.....Radio Caroline have plans to produce a official magazine sometime in the New Year. If you would like to write an article for the mag., write to:- Caroline, A321, Rosas, Girona, Spain. Remember the postage is 11p....
On Sun. 14th Nov. Radio Dublin had an exclusive interview with Marianne Faithful.....The Town Council of Pyla de Aro have published statistics in which they admit that since Radio Mi Amigo set up offices in that town, the tourism has increased by 15%.....9.00 to 13.00hrs (G.M.T.) it's Radio Valleri - the Action Station! They operate from Dublin City and broadcast every Sunday on 6260KHz 49mb S.W. D.J.'s: Derek Jones and Mike Anderson. The new address for R.V. is:- 47 Claremont Drive, Glasnevin, Dublin 9, Ireland.....It's been rumoured that the Editor has a Radio One calendar!.....Radio Dublin using 1,000 watts also R.D. now claims to have had more publicity over the past year than all the pirates together since 1966.....Sat. 12th Dec. '76 and Radio Mi Amigo is now on 192 metres/156KHz. Reason for change is that listeners in the Benelux were experiencing interference from the 135Kw Radio Budapest transmitter on the same channel (253). Radio Caroline is now on 259 metres 24 hours a day.....Wed. 15th Dec. and the Editor had the pleasure of attending the first 'Radio Dublin Club' rave-up at The Crampton Court in Dame Street in Dublin's City Centre. Good time had by all. Great idea Don - give us more!!!
...Anyone been to Robin's Records????Premier Radio International making a great comeback on S.W. - Sundays 8.00 to 11.00hrs (G.M.T.) on 6240KHz 49mb. D.J.'s include: Jimmy St. Ledger and Gerry Stivell. Mailing address:- P.R.I., 47 Claremont Drive, Glasnevin, Dublin 9, Ireland.....Radio Caroline has more than 5 million listeners - that's more than any other commercial radio station in Europe.....Radio Valleri has commenced Medium wave transmissions on 227 metres/1320KHz.....MYSTERY OF THE MONTH
A station was logged in France on 6255KHz at 14.30hrs (G.M.T.) on Sun. 31st Oct. '76 called: The Voice Of Ireland. We have no records to suggest such a station exists. Anyone got any ideas????.....

RADIO SOLENT CITY INTERNATIONAL - BRIEF HISTORY BY MICHAEL JAY.....

Began in June 1970 on 6600KHz. Short Wave service ceased in 1971 and Medium Wave started alternatively on 227metres/1320KHz using 10 watts. In 1975 power was increased to 15 and then to 150 watts. On 1st August '76 Radio Solent City International recommenced it's S.W. transmissions. First test was put out on 6280KHz and due to the excellent response, we have broadcast twice a month since then. We have a DX programme at 12.30hrs G.M.T. on the last Sunday of every month. Our tx. power on 1/8/76 was 15watts. This was increased to 50 watts and at present we're running 150 watts on 6280KHz. Over the next year further tests will be carried out on S.W. on the following bands:- 41m, 31m and 25m. Low powered tests are being tried on 7425KHz and 8980KHz at random times. We welcome tapes from other D.J.'s and requests from listeners. We reply to all letters and verify reports with our Q.S.L. and a free car sticker.
