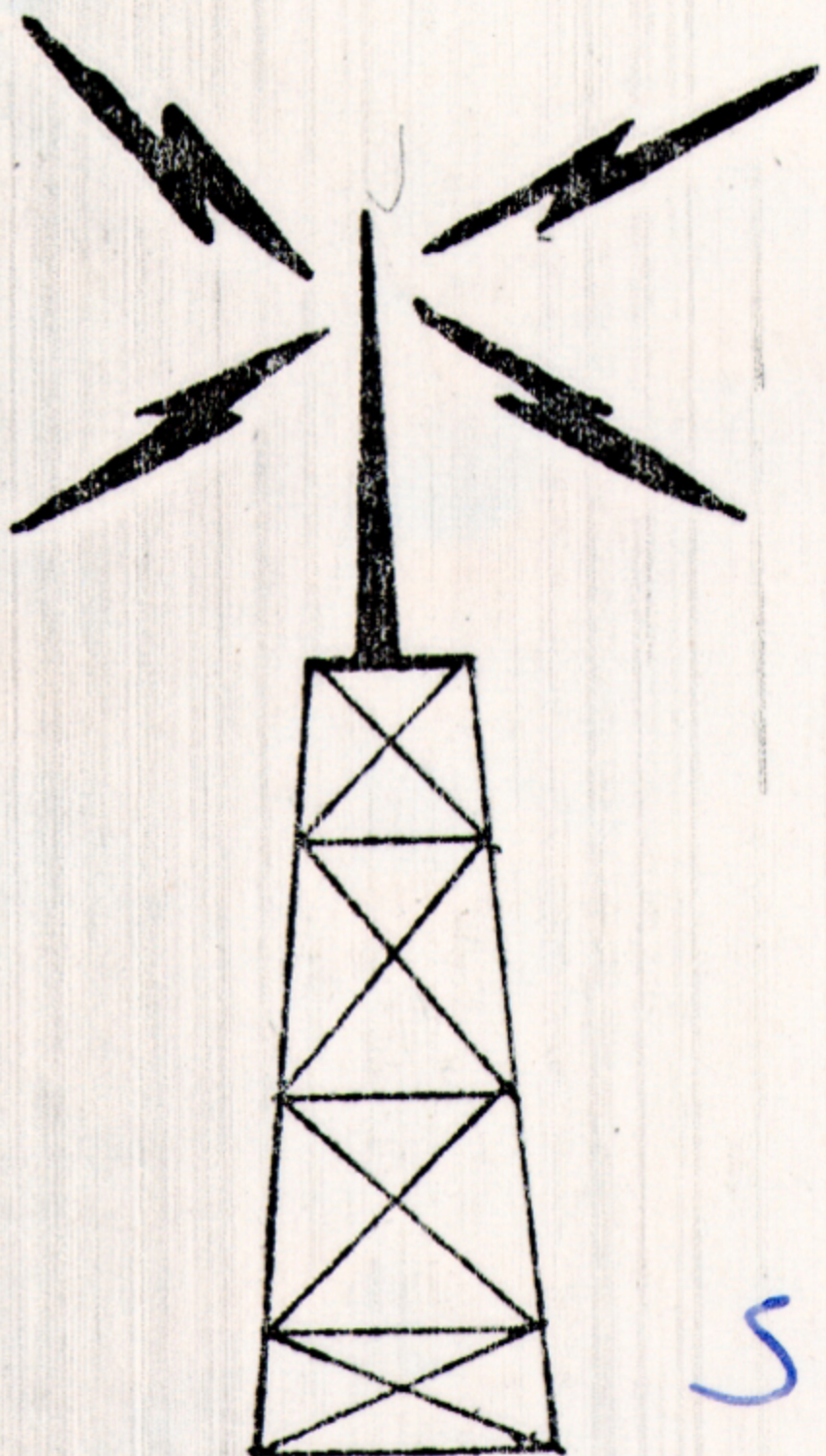

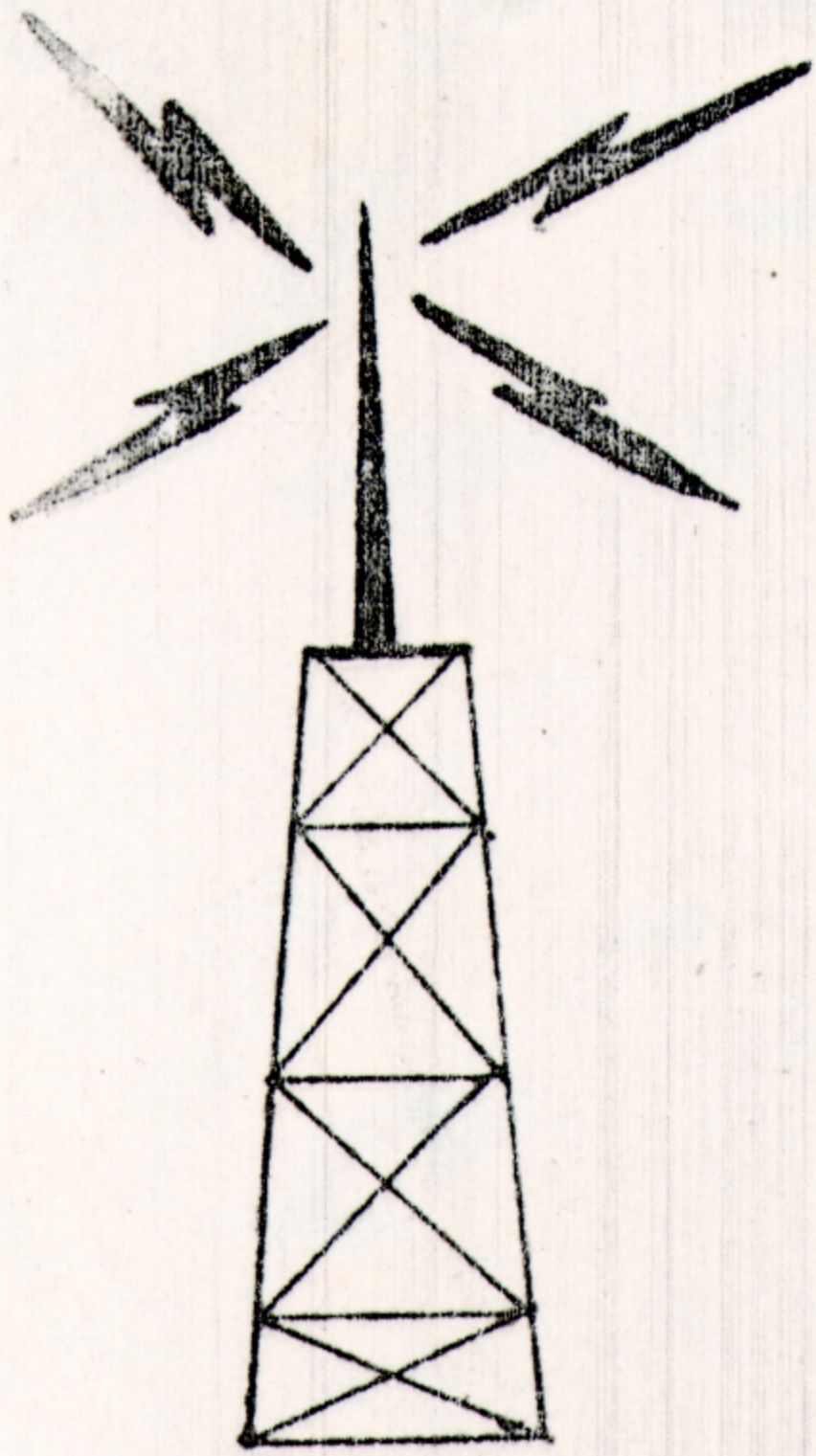

Dear *Dan*

First of all, sincere apologies for not writing to you sooner, but it is only now, we have got around to clearing the backlog of reception reports. We checked your report with the particular presenter, who was broad-casting at the time that you mentioned in your letter, and we are pleased to say that it is correct in every detail.

Community Radio Youghal (C.R.Y.) is an independant broad-casting station serving Youghal town (Pop. 6,500) and the surrounding areas. Our broad-casting hours are:- 11.30 a.m. - 18.30 p.m. each day. On week-ends however we have late-night programmes commencing at 23.00 p.m. going on until 03.00 a.m.

Reception reports from these night-time programmes have been got as far away as 'West Germany' although the bulk of our reports have been got from DX'rs in Western Europe.

Among the programmes that C.R.Y produces and presents are local community affairs and events, Religious programmes aimed at the house-wife, school goers, career guidance etc.

C.R.Y. was started on the 4th July 1979, to provide a local alternative to the national station and since it's inception has proved to be a resounding success.
