## HISTORY OF RADIO DUBLIN

Radio Dublin started in 1966. It was started by Rodger Llyod (Prince Terry) and Ken Sheehan (Ken Edwards). At that time we only broadcast on Sunday afternoons. The station made no real progress until 1973/74 when a lot of disc jockeys from Nass County Kildare joined the station. With so many D.J.'s we could afford to go on Saturday afternoon as well as most of Sunday. In late 1974 the transmitter broke down and Eamon Cooke was asked to fix it. Eamon began to take an interest in Radio Dublin and in time Rodger and Ken dropped out, leaving Eamon and Doctor Don to manage the station. In 1976 another station was set up in Dublin by Doctor Don and Dave C. another Dublin D.J. This station was called A.R.D. which stands for Alternative Radio Dublin. Eamon kept Radio Dublin going, and in December 1977 he could see that our listeners needed more than just a weekend alternative to R.T.E., (the national network). So for a three week period over the Christmas we broadcast for 24 hours a day. After Christmas Eamon found that people would not accept the idea of Radio Dublin broadcasting on weekends only, so he gave up his television repair shop and went full time into running Radio Dublin. At this stage the D.J.'s from Nass had left one by one, and the new staff were all from Dublin. This worked out very well until Eamon now known as the Captain, took a holiday in April '78. The D.J.'s decided they wanted more say in running the station, and they went about setting up there own which was known as Sig D., They left Radio Dublin in a devastated condition with the intention of us never broadcasting again. Eamon returned from his holiday and went to work straight away on repairing the damage and within twelve hours of his return Radio Dublin was back on the airwaves of Dublin. D.J.'s came from every part of the city and so staffing the station proved no problem. We have changed the line up from time to time since then. In the last year we built up our second channel, and it is going very well at the moment. We are now the only local radio station in Ireland who broadcast seperate programmes on seperate channels

The second channel is for specialised programmes only, for instance we have a country show, a students show, a soul show, and several rock shows. We plan in the near future to broadcast a current affairs programme. Last season we had a medical show and also a classical show.

Radio Dublin Channel one broadcast Mon-Fri, on 2.5.3.meters Medium wave also 235meteres medium wave, 90.2 F.M. and 6317KHZ.on shortwave the 47 meter band.

I do hope you hear Radio Dublin in the very near future.

Opening Hours: Mon.- Sat. We are broadcasting 24 hours a day. Sunday night/ Monday morning we close down at 3.a.m. and reopen at 7.a.m.

The 24 hours refer to Radio Dublin Channel 1 only.
