This station have not been heard this week, and have presumably closed down. Initially it was thought that the station may simply have reduced its hours, but they were not heard at all on Friday afternoon nor over the weekend. ex-MAR DJ, Steve Bishop is now reported to be operating a RADIO ATLANTIS on 1242kHz from the Worcester area, although reports from that area say that the signal is very weak.

RADIO MERSEYWAVES 94.8MHz FM: 23, Birnam Road, Poulton, Wallasey, Merseyside L44 9AY.

This station had a carrier on their MW frequency shortly before 10am on Sunday.

They appear to have played continuous music from 10am to 11am, when John Freeman openthe station. Heard to 6pm were: - 11am-Noon Mr "F"; Noon-2pm Tony Reeve; 2pm-3pm John Freeman; 3pm-4pm Paul Jay; 4pm-6pm John Freeman. At 6pm the FM transmitter came on the air in parallel with 1179kHz (which I forgot to include above:). The announced schedule of Tina Christian 6pm-7pm, Bert Williams 7pm-9:30pm; Paul Jay 9:30pm-11pm; Tina Christian 11pm-Midnight close-down by Tony Reeve seems to have been somwhat amended. Tina Christian was heard 6pm-7pm, followed by Bert Williams, but at 10:30pm Paul Jay seems only just to have come on the air. Later programming was not heard.

This station appears to be operating from 9am - 9pm on Saturdays, but the regular DJ line-up has not been established, and from 10am to 8pm on Sundays. Regular DJs are Jim Browne, Jeff Stone, Howie, Phil Davies, Dave Smith, Ian Phillips and Gary Stephens. If Mark Evans is still with the station, his programmes have not been noted here for some time.

STORETON COMMUNITY RADIO 1026kHz: 23, The Meadow, Woodchurch Estate, Merseyside L45 8HX
The station have operated their 24-hour, 7-day format for some weeks now and
seem to have "cracked" the problems associated with keeping a transmitter on the air
continuously. They have been on the air whenever I have tuned-in, no matter at what
hour of the day. Their daily schedule, however, continues to elude me.
