RADIO MERSEYWAVES: 1242kHz & 94.8MHz; 18, Mallard Way, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 7SL

This station is the only Merseyside station to be heard this weekend and they were not without their problems. Sign-on time on Saturday was not noted, but was apparently 11am. The announced schedule was:- 11am-Noon Jim Lowe; Noon-2pm Tom Webb; 2pm-4pm Paul Henderson; 4pm-6pm Steve Jones; 6pm-8pm Tara; 8pm-10pm Martin Miller; 10pm- Midnight Mark Newman. It seems that Paul Henderson didn't turn up to present his programme and the gap was filled by Tom Webb doing Noon-3pm and Steve Jones doing 3pm-6pm. Station announcements said that Paul Henderson had had a heavy cold all week. Reception was very good for most of the day but deteriorated badly during the Martin Miller and Mark Newman shows. At the time, the problem seemed to be very strong co-channel interference, but this may be incorrect as the station were not heard on Sunday on either AM or FM. Most of the presenters are announcing Radio Merseywaves as "the only Medium Wave pirate station left in the North West" but this is not correct as KFM in Stockport are currently operating on 101.7kHz with a much better signal now that Radio Sunshine, Ludlow have vacated this frequency.
