On Sunday the station had a few problems. The carrier was noted at 10:26am, but had gone from the air by llam. Programming wasn't heard until 1:25pm, with a probable lpm opening. Paul Jay was supposed to be on the air till 3pm, but when checked at 2:58pm, the station had again disappeared. From 4:10pm intermittant modulation was noted and the station finally got back on the air at 4:30pm. Burt Williams announced that there had been a few problems, firstly with the modulator, then with flash-over in the antenna circuits. Butt was on the air till 6pm, then heard were: - 6pm-8pm Mark Newman; 8pm 10pm Martin Miller and 10pm-12:09am close-down Paul Henderson.
