This week has been a disappointment with only Radio Merseywaves being heard. On Wednesday 15th, the Liverpool Echo carried a report on a Court case involving Storeton Community Radio who were accused of causing serious interference on shipping frequencies. One fine of £50 and two of £25 were imposed on the operators and equipment worth £2000 was ordered to be confiscated.

Heard on Saturday were:- 10am-noon Steve Jones; Noon-5pm Mark Newman; 5pm-6pm Paul Jay, 6pm-8pm Tara; 8pm-10pm was supposed to be Martin Miller but appeared to be continuous music till 9:40pm, when Mark Newman took over till lam close-down Sunday sign-on time wasn't noted but is thought to be 10am, and heard were:- 10am(?)-1pm Steve Jones; 1pm-3pm Paul Jay; 3pm-5pm Paul Henderson; 5pm-8pm Mark Newman; 8pm-10pm Martin Miller; 10pm-Midnight close-down Paul Henderson.
