On Saturday, none of the local stations were on the air by noon, so I went out without the radio. By the time I arrived back home, both Central Radio and Storeton Community Radio were on the air, and the earlier schedules had been missed.

CENTRAL RADIO INTERNATIONAL 1404kHz: 30, Elkstone Road, Norris Green, Liverpool Lll 2DK. This station wasn't noted until 5:10pm, when the Phil Davies Show was heard. The signal was weak and speech modulation so poor that Phil was mostly unreadable. He signedoff at 6pm, when the Jim Browne/Mark Evans joint show should have taken over. For a while the signal was intermittant, and the crew were obviously trying to make adjustments. Things did not improve, and the station seems to have closed-down at about 6:30pm. They have not been heard at all on Sunday.

KISS-FM 102.85MHz FM(s): 150, Rake Lane, Wallasey, Merseyside L45 lJW.

This station, which, until recently put in a very strong signal, is no longer heard here an a pocket-portable receiver. They are, however, announcing reception reports from as far away as Stafford and the Lake District, with excellent signal strength in Burnley. The conclusion must be that the transmitter location has been moved some considerable distance. Heard today were: Noon-lpm Continuous music(possibly Alan Ross Show); 1pm-2pm Mark Wright; 2pm-4pm Tony Hayes; 4pm-6pm Colin Sayer.

STORFTON COMMUNITY RADIO 1026kHz: 23, The Meadow, Woodchurch Estate, Birkenhead, Merseyside L49 8HX.

This station was not noted on Friday night and were not heard by noon on Saturday. They were first noted at 4:10pm on Saturday, with Keith the Chief in the hot seat. The line-up noted was: - 4pm-6pm Keith the Chief; 6pm-8pm Edward Bear; 8pm-10pm Uncle Ern; 10pm-Midnight Brian "C"; Midnight-lam Joe Williams (?).
