This station was first noted at about 12:40pm on Sunday although they announce Mon/Tues/Wed/Thur operation as well. They were presumably on the air through the week as they seem to have had plenty of requests and dedications for the Sunday broadcast. Heard were:-Noon(?)-2pm Dave Moore; 2pm-4pm Phil Smith; 4pm-6;30pm Dave Moore; 6:30pm-?? Mike Hughes. The latter was supposed to be on the air till 10:30pm, but when checked at 10:15pm the station had gone. Throughout the day they say that they were having difficulties with equipment but the signal sounded good.

RADIO MERSEYWAVES 1242kHz & 981kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 7W This station were on the air all day Monday but the early line-up isn't known. Heard 4pm-6pm was Paul James. During Tara's show(6pm-8pm), Keith the Chief asked Burt Williams and Mark Newman to call at the studio urgently. Heard from 8pm-10pm was DJC, who also stood in for Mark Newman from 10pm-Midnight, during which time, SCR were asked over the air to med Mark Newman. At this stage it was first noted that SCR were also on the air. On Friday, the schedule for the early part of the day is still not known, but heard were:- ??-7pm Martin Miller; 7pm-9pm Dave Collins; 9pm-Midnight Paul Baker, a new DJ; Midnight - ??

Heard Sunday were:- 9am-1lam Dave Collins; 1lam-lpm Wayne Scott; 1pm-3pm Paul Jay; 3pm-5pm Burt Williams; 5pm-7pm Keith the Chief; 7pm-10pm Martin Miller; 10pm-Midnight Mark Newman; Midnight-lam Keith the Chief, who was to have been followed by DJC from lam-2am(or so)

STORETON COMMUNITY RADIO 1026kHz: 23, The Meadow, Woodchurch Estate, Birkenhead, This station was on the air on Monday but wasn't noted until Merseyside, L49 8HX. 10:15pm. Heard were:- 10:15pm-llpm Dave Dee and llam-Midnight close-down Larry James. With regard to the weekend schedule, the station is on par with Bill Shankley's famous football team, ie "the same as last week". The only differences to their annonced schedule have been Joe Williams standing-in for Mike Martyn Midnight-2am on Friday, Martin "C" in for Jeff Jones Midnight-2am on Saturday, Paul Western standing-in for Nick Stafford 3pm-5pm Sunday and Dave Dee in for Larry James 7pm-l0pm Sunday. Most of these changes seem to have been caused by staff holidays
