The station say that they were back on the air later, but this broadcast wasn't noted here. Concept reported that the CRI studio wasn't fully ready, but the station themselves say that they had "mic" problems, which prevented them from doing "live" broadcasts.

ARFIELD COMMUNITY RADIO; 1413kHz: 111, Pinehurst Avenue, Anfield, Liverpool L4 7UG
This station was not found before noon, after which, it was "buried" under Central Radio.
At 2:36pm, with the latter off air, ACR were heard with a close-down announcement. Mark
Evans said that too many people were aware of the station's location and it seems that
some of them had taken revenge for local interference. They say that they plan to make
a return to the airwaves in two weeks time from a different location. In the meantime,
Central Radio say that they also made a later broadcast that was missed here.

CONCEPT RADIO 104.3MHx; 18, Glynne Street, Orrell, Bootle, Merseyside L20 6DF.
"Keith" apparently turned up late for his programme on Sunday. Concept at the moment,
