## OTHER NEWS:

At 3:49pm on Sunday, the BBC Lancashire announcer on 103.9MHz said that the station was having problems with their signal, due to "a pirate radio station, who are surrounding us and attempting to take over our frequency" He didn't say which frequency was being affected, but there was no sign of any pirate station on either 103.9MHz or 104.5MHz. Medium Wave frequencies weren't checked as there is no local pirate station on 855kHz, and 1557kHz is obliterated here by splatter from BBC Merseyside.

The TODAY newspaper reported on 22nd November that RADIO LASER would be back on the air from 1st December, on 531kHz. On Thursday 20th November, a station had been heard "testing" with continuous Beatle's music around o2:00 UTC on 531kHz. On 1st Dec. they apparently opened with a large selection of off-shore "jingles" from the 60's and were noted here only briefly with Radio Caroline jingles and programming. Contrary to previous press reports, Neil Frazer said that he had picked them up with Radio Veronica programming, but on 576kHz, where they were "mixing" badly with a co-channel Arabic station and could only be heard when the latter faded.
