Not many stations have been noted this week, and most of those that were heard had some form of equipment problems of DJ shortages.

RADIO MERSEY WAVES 1242kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 7UW. Bank Holiday Monday saw a few "stand-in" DJs and at the weekend the signal was carrying some distortion. Bert Williams announced that they had increased power, and in spite of going off the air a few times for "adjustments", the signal didn't improve. The Sunday afternoon line-up wasn't fully heard so it isn't known whether Peter Thomas stood-in for Burt for the full two hours, specially as at 5pm, Burt was heard to announce that the broadcast might be interupted for "adjustments" Noted this week have been:-

c/down till next Friday Last weekend, Andy Davies announced that 8 to 10 DJs had left the station, but things don't seem to be as bad as he visualised. Off-hand, I can only think of Paula "P", Andy Rogers and Larry James who have not been heard on the air this weekend. No doubt there are a few more who I have overlooked.

SLAG-OFF INT 105.3MHz: 132, Norwood Road, Poulton, Wallasey, Merseyside L44 4EG This station has been noted three times this week, with a very indefinite schedule on each occasion. They were noted from 8:20pm on Monday with Mike Hughes in the "hot

seat", but had gone when next checked at 9:15pm. They were back on the air from 7pm(?) Saturday (first noted at 7:10pm) with Steve Mason in the chair. Once again, close-down time wasn't noted, but the station had gone from the air when checked at 8:50pm. On Sunday they were first noted at 8:01pm, apparently with a joint Mike Hughes/Steve Mason show till 10:15pm close-down

From approximately 4:45pm on Sunday, a station playing continuous music was noted on 104.4MHz. At first, it was believed that this signal may have originated from a slightly "off-tune" Concept Radio although the weaker signal strength suggested not. Many of the tapes featured the "Jackie Blue" tune, which used to be the theme tune of Rick Dane's Radio Jackie North. This weekend, Radio Atlantis have been announcing plans for an FM outlet although nothing definite has been noted. This station closed down at 8:48pm exactly and at first it was thought that they started to relay BBC LANCASHIRE at this time, but later investigations showed that the BBC Lancs broadcast was the "real thing".

In sending greetings to the other local pirate radio operators, Neil Bishop said that when they get back on the air, Liverpool Pirate Radio will probably be on 266m (1125 or 1134kHz) rather than the present 1404kHz.
