They were on the air with a FREE RADIO DAY special on Thursday, but were back to normal by Friday. They say that they will go 7-day and extend their hours as soon as they can recruit some new DJs. Most stations advertise themselves as "Less chat and more music", but Radio Atlantis are the only one to put this policy into action. So much so, that it is often impossible to tell at times whether they are playing continuous music. Very pleasant listening and a complete change from anything else that can be heard here.
