In a week when Radio Atlantis has gone over to 7-day operation, Radio Julie has closed down and Horizon Radio, composed of some of the Radio Julie DJs has been on the air for a short "test" broadcast. Radio Veronica, Concept Radio, Slag-Off Int and Scott FM have not been heard at all.

RADIO MERSEY WAVES: 1242kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 70W. The schedule for this station has been "shuffled round" a bit, apparently as a result of holidays. Over the weekend, and particularly on Sunday, their FM link was subject to a lot of interference from CBers, which went out "loud and clear" on Medium Wave. Dave Collins is now back with the station. RADIO ATLANTIS 936kHz: 150, Rake Lane, Wallasey, Merseyside L45 1JW.

On Sunday, this station announced that they are now a 7-day operation and though not heard here, other sources confirm that the station have indeed been on the air every day. After 8pm on Sunday, they planned to relay one of the local FM stations, but like myself, they don't seem to have been able to hear one! Andy Davies (the original Andy Davies from a number of old-time Merseyside radio stations) was due to appear on the station on Sunday, but later announcements said that his car had let him down and he couldn't make it. They were hoping that he would be on the air over the next few days instead. Their schedule appears to have been:

RADIO JULIE 104.8MHz: 112, Greenwood Road, Woodchurch Estate, Birkenhead, Merseyside
This station was not found till 9:16pm on Friday, after apparently signing on at L49 8HU
9pm. All the DJs announced that the station would be closing down "for a couple of
months" at midnight, but Andy Davies seemed less than optimistic when he said that the
station would be back "by Christmas". The other DJs trotted out the same old story about
coning back "with increased power and increased hours" although one of the DJs did say
that this depended on how many DJs were available and passed a few comments about the
Julie DJs who have gone off to foem their own station. On Friday, Andy Davies said that
the station was operating on lower power from a different location. Because the station
chose to go out in a blaze of glory, with a phone-in, which made the schedule hard to
follow. Noted were:-

HORIZON RADIO 105.3MHz: 11, Massey Street, Birkenhead, Merseyside L41 4JU.

This station was noted from 11:39am on Sunday, after apparently signing-on at llam. The broadcast noted was announced as a "test" by Neil Bishop and closed-down at 12:08pm
The DJs were announced as Neil Bishop, DJ Crezzey, Toni West (note the spelling), Tony Hayes (ex Atlantis) and DJ Trix. They hope to be on the air from 7pm on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings

Latest - Mon 13th July

Radio Mersey Waves disappeared from the air sometime between 12:20pm and 2pm today. They were back shortly before 6pm, saying that the DTI had attempted to raid them. Radio Atlantis disappeared from the air at 3:58pm during the playing of their theme tune. At the time of writing, the fate of this station isn't known, but the lack of phone calls to "others" is taken to be a good sign!
