RADIO MERSEY WAVES 1242kHz: 9, Meadfoot Road, Moreton, Wirral, Merseyside L46 7UN This station operated normally on Monday, though the late night line-up was missed. They failed to show up on Friday morning, but a very "hissy" carrier was noted on the air by 7:30pm. This carrier appears to have been on the air till some time around lpm on Saturday, but no programming or announcements were noted. NORTH COAST RADIO 1350kHz: 18, Downham Drive, Heswall, Wirral, Merseyside L60 5RF.
On Sun/Mon this station was possibly on the air all night as they were going strong when checked at 8:10am. Later announcements said that Roy had been on the air since
7:30am and that before 8am they had already held a phone-in. Later in the day they seem to have had problems with "missing" DJs. On Friday, the carrier was on the air by
8am, but programming wasn't noted till 3pm. On Saturday they weren't on the air till
11:30am, but were already on the air when first checked at 8:50am on Sunday. The format from 10pm on Sunday wasn't noted, but otherwise heard were:Mona 7:30(2)cm Roy; 10am Dave Moore; Noor carrier only; 12:30pm Ritchie "C"; 2pm Paul

RADIO ATLANTIS 1197kHz: 150, Rake Lane, Liscard, Wallasey, Merseyside L45 LJW

At 11am sign—on on Saturday, Steve Bishop announced that the station would be operating a new format from this weekend. They were also to have extended programming till 2am on Sunday morning with another Rick Dane Rock Show. On Sunday they were to have opened at 9am with the return of the Free Radio Show. The non-stop nature of many of the shows makes the format difficult to determine just from spot—checks and much of the Saturday afternoon format was lost, though Rick Dane wasn't heard at all. Also, they seem to have closed—down at 10pm after an un—scheduled andy Davies show. On Sunday after a very short transmitter warm—up, they opened with non—stop music till till 10am and the start of the Steve Bishop Show but no Free Radio Show. Rick Dane wasn't heard, but later announcements said that he was working hard to build a bigger transmitter in time for the Christmas shows.
