None of the local stations seems to have any definite plans for their Christmas broadcasting and nothing is known about Central Radio' planned Christmas "special"

NORTH COAST RADIO 1350kHz: 18, Downham Drive, Heswall, Wirral, Merseyside L60 5RF

This station appears to be so dis-organised that on Saturday, Tony Hollis, who is supposed to be the station manager, started to read out the format for the rest of the weekend, but even he gave up when he got to lopm on Saturday. Many DJs are failing to turn up for their shows and plans to be on the air every day over the holiday period seem very optimistic. On Monday no-one turned up to take over from LJ Cressey and the station was off the air between 10am(?) and 3pm(?). On Friday they didn't open till 11:30am and they weren't on the air till 10:30am on Saturday. They say that they will be on the air next Saturday, but hope to be able to do some broadcasting on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. The long spells on the air by some of the DJs are divided into virtually non-stop music of various sorts, but the format is still difficult to determine and has this weekend been disrupted by changes to announced format. On Saturday they closed down at Midnight rather than extending to 2am with the Rick Dane Rock Show. On Sunday, they closed down at 10:15pm, with an announcement by Steve Bishop that they would be back again next Friday!!
